# Present vs Past Tense

## Conjugation Summary Chart



	+	-	?
PRESENT	You <b>live</b> in Spain.	You <b>don't live</b> in Spain.	<b>Do you live</b> in Spain?
PAST	You <b>lived</b> in Spain.	You <b>didn't live</b> in Spain.	<b>Did you live</b> in Spain?
PRESENT	He <b>lives</b> in Spain.	He <b>doesn't live</b> in Spain.	<b>Does he live</b> in Spain?
PAST	He <b>lived</b> in Spain.	He <b>didn't live</b> in Spain.	<b>Did he live</b> in Spain?

The verb only changes in affirmative sentences.

In negative sentences and questions the verb doesn't change. The base form of the infinitive is used.

El verbo solo cambia en oraciones positivas/afirmativas.

En negativo y preguntas el verbo no cambia. Se usa sólo la forma base (infinitivo) del verbo.

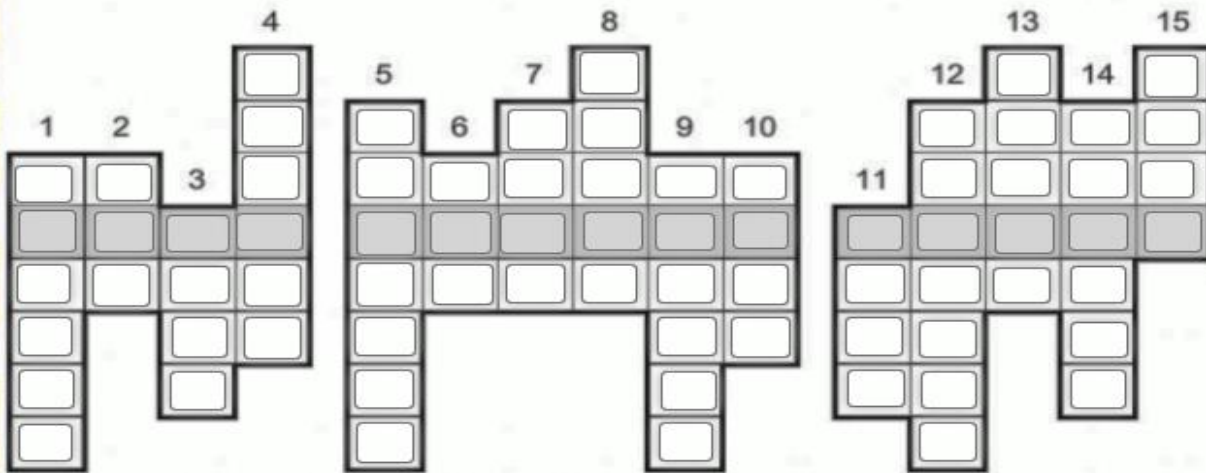
