This week we are working with worksheet N° 6 and our main topic is "Will". Let's get started.

El futuro con **"will"** se utiliza para hablar de decisiones que se toman mientras se habla:

"Will"

Ejemplos:

- **I need to get my medicine. I will go to the pharmacy tonight.**
Necesito comprar mi medicina. Iré a la farmacia esta noche.
- **I need some cash. I will pay with my debit card and ask for cash back.**
Necesito algo de efectivo. Pagaré con mi tarjeta débito y pediré efectivo de vuelta.

También es usado para decir predicciones de carácter general:

Ejemplos:

- **I'm sure it will rain tomorrow.**
Estoy seguro de que va a llover mañana.
- **Gerardo Gómez will win the election.**
Gerardo Gómez va a ganar las elecciones.

Se forma con el verbo "will" + verbo:

- I **will pay** later.
- You **will pay** later.
- He **will pay** later.
- She **will pay** later.
- It **will pay** later.
- We **will pay** later.
- You **will pay** later.
- They **will pay** later.

Afirmativo

Forma larga	Sujeto + will + v. en infinitivo sin "to" + ...
Forma corta	Sujeto + 'll + v. en infinitivo sin "to" + ...

Ejemplos

I'll play tennis tomorrow.	Jugaré al tenis mañana.
He will leave London next month.	Dejará Londres el próximo mes.

Forma larga	Forma corta
I shall/will work	I'll work
You will work	You'll work
He will work	He'll work
She will work	She'll work
It will work	It'll work
We shall/will work	We'll work
You will work	You'll work
They will work	They'll work

Negativo

Forma larga	Sujeto + will + not + v. en infinitivo sin "to" + ...
Forma corta	Sujeto + won't + v. en infinitivo sin "to" + ...
	Sujeto + 'll + not + verbo en infinitivo sin "to" + ...

Ejemplos:

I'll not visit your mother tomorrow.	No visitaré a tu madre mañana.
You will not paint the office.	No pintaréis la oficina.

Forma larga	Forma corta	
I will not work	I won't work	I'll not work
You will not work	You won't work	You'll not work
He will not work	He won't work	He'll not work
She will not work	She won't work	She'll not work
It will not work	It won't work	It'll not work
We will not work	We won't work	We'll not work
You will not work	You won't work	You'll not work
They will not work	They won't work	They'll not work
