He **studied** history. — Simple Past

He **was fired**. — Simple Past Passive

He **was living** in Chicago. — Past Continuous

Other examples

Simple Past: *was, grew up, got, went, decided, traveled, took, posted, moved, thought, had, arrived, didn't know, photographed, called, loved, became*

Simple Past Passive: *was fired, was featured, was published*

Past Continuous: *was living*

2. *had worked* is the first action, followed by *was fired*.

Past Perfect = *had* + past participle

Other examples: *had predicted, could not have happened*

3. *Used to* expresses an action that happened many times.

Another example: *used to spend*


